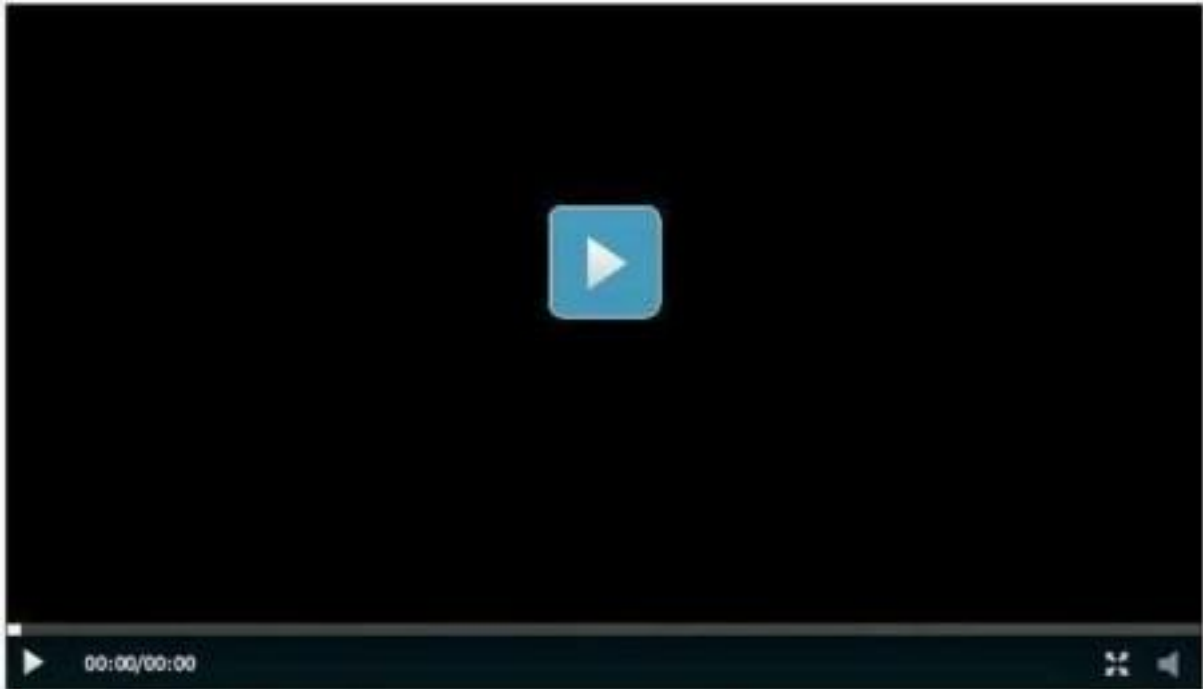

'I couldn't bring two chocolates for my kids'

Rajesh Kumar, celebrated for roles in 'Sarabhai vs Sarabhai', is back, thanks to 'Saiyaara's' success. The film, a romantic drama, has grossed over Rs 400 crore worldwide. Rajesh faced severe financial struggles, including a Rs 2 crore debt, leading him to farming in 2019. The pandemic worsened his situation, leaving him nearly bankrupt. 'Saiyaara' has given him a much-needed comeback.

Rajesh Kumar, best known for his roles in popular shows like 'Sarabhai vs Sarabhai', Excuse Me Maadam, and 'Kota Factory', is finally back in the spotlight. Thanks to his supporting role in 'Saiyaara', the actor has found his place again in the film industry. The romantic drama, directed by Mohit Suri and starring newcomers Ahaan Panday and Aneet Padda, turned out to be a massive box office hit. Released in July, 'Saiyaara' opened to good reviews and shocked everyone with its numbers. The film has already made over Rs 400 crore worldwide and is expected to cross Rs 500 crore soon. While Rajesh is now enjoying success, has shared that he went through a very tough time not long ago, one that involved financial loss, emotional stress, and a strong comeback.

Rajesh had decided to quit acting in 2019 and took up farming. But things didn't go as planned. He wanted to break the myth that farming is only for people with no better career choices. "Nobody these days dreams of becoming a farmer when they grow up," he said, explaining how he hoped to change people's views about farming.

Rajesh had barely started farming when things began to go wrong. First, weather conditions affected his crops, and then the pandemic made it even worse. Speaking to Rajshri Unplugged, he said, "Financially, I was on a slide. By the lockdown, I had used up my savings, and was literally bankrupt. I didn't have anything in my pocket. I had huge loans, and that was adding to the pressure."The lack of income during that time meant Rajesh couldn't even manage basic survival, despite trying his best.

Rajesh also shared a heartbreaking memory of when he worked on a film called 'Binny and Family'. He had to travel to the UK for a 24-day shoot, but money was so tight that he couldn't afford to bring anything back for his children. In an interview with Dainik Bhaskar, he said, "I had just Rs 2,500 in my bank account when I was in the UK. I traveled back and forth twice during that 24-day shoot, but I couldn't bring back even two chocolates for my kids."

Throughout this difficult time, Rajesh said it was his family that stood by him and gave him the strength to keep going. He admitted that he wasn't earning enough to even survive, and without his loved ones helping him out, he may not have made it through. In an older interview with Galatta India, he said that farming made him a better actor. “Farming helped me become a better actor. Now, whenever my role demands emotions, I simply remember my farming days and tear up.” He laughed as he said, “I don’t have to visualise as an actor that my parents died or a friend died, I simply remember: ‘Arey yaar, khet mein aag lag gaya tha uss din (The farm caught fire the other day)’,” he said.

The actor says he went bankrupt after quitting acting to take up farming. Rajesh Kumar, known for his iconic role as Rosesh Sarabhai in *Sarabhai vs Sarabhai*, has made a successful comeback with Mohit Suri’s *Saiyaara*. The romantic drama, starring debutants Ahaan Panday and Aneet Padda, has stunned the industry with its box office numbers — grossing over ₹4,000 million (₹4 billion) worldwide.

In *Saiyaara*, Rajesh plays the father of Vaani Batra (Aneet), a young journalist diagnosed with early-onset Alzheimer’s. His performance has earned praise for its emotional depth — something he says came from personal experience. Rajesh recently told Zoom that his portrayal in *Saiyaara* felt deeply personal, as his own mother is battling the same illness. “When I heard the script, I didn’t need to act. I just had to feel it,” he said. “I see my father, who’s not vocal about his suffering, and that inspired the silence in my performance.”

In 2019, Rajesh Kumar stepped away from the spotlight and turned to farming. His aim: to break the stigma that farming is a last resort. “Nobody grows up wanting to be a farmer. I wanted to change that mindset,” he told *Meri Saheli*.

During a shoot for *Binny and Family* in the UK, Rajesh recalled being unable to buy even two chocolates for his kids. “That was rock bottom,” he told *Dainik Bhaskar*. His financial downfall was compounded by back-to-back setbacks — unpredictable weather and the pandemic. “By the time lockdown hit, I had used up all my savings. I was literally bankrupt,” he told *Rajshri Unplugged*.

Despite the hardship, Rajesh credits the experience for shaping him as an actor. “Farming made me better. When I need to cry on screen, I just remember the day my fields caught fire,” he laughed in an interview with Galatta India. Amid the chaos, his family was his only anchor. “They stood by me when I had nothing,” he said. Rajesh believes it’s time to dismantle the myth that farming is for those with no other options. “We need to inspire future generations to see farming as a noble profession.”

While his past few years were marked by personal and financial challenges, Rajesh is now basking in the success of *Saiyaara*. With critics applauding his grounded

performance and the film poised to cross ₹5,000 million (₹5 billion) globally, the actor says it feels like the tide has finally turned.
